This is a flower arranger's garden. A third of an acre includes mixed borders, meadow and woodland areas, scented garden, gravelled herb garden and vegetable/fruit garden and a late summer border.

Admission £4; tea/coffee and cake £2

Directions. On the A49 towards Hereford turn right into Wellington village. Pass the church on the right, then just after the barn on the left turn left up the driveway in front of The Harbour, continue to the furthest bungalow.

Tuesday 22nd June, 7pm. Broxwood Court, Broxwood, near Pembridge, HR6 9JJ *Owned by Richard Snead and Mike and Anne Allen*.

An impressive 29 acre garden and arboretum designed in 1859 by W. Nesfield for the greatgrandfather of the present owner. Magnificent yew hedges and 1 km long avenue of cedars and Scots Pines. Spectacular view of the Black Mountains. Sweeping lawns, rhododendrons and a gentle walk to the summer-house, chapel and ponds. Rose garden, mixed borders, rill, gazebo, sculpted benches and fountain. Peacocks and white doves.

Admission £5; tea/coffee and cake £3

Directions. From Leominster follow the A44/A4112 towards Brecon. After approx.8 miles, just past Weobley, turn off right to Broxwood/ Pembridge. After 2 miles go straight over the crossroads to Lyonshall. After 500 yards, the garden is on the left over a cattle grid.

Tuesday 20th July, 2.30pm. Westonbury Water Mill Gardens, near Pembridge, HR6 9HZ **Please note this is an afternoon visit.

Owned by Richard and Sally Pim.

Three and a half acre water mill garden set amid fields and orchards. Colourful waterside plantings of bog and water-loving plants around a tangle of streams and ponds, together with a natural bog garden. Adjacent wild-flower meadow and streamside walk. A series of dotty and delightful follies including a giant cuckoo clock and a stone water tower with resident dove.

Admission £7.50 or £6 if our group comprises 15+ people. Light lunches and teas can be purchased from the on-site cafe.

Directions. From Leominster take the A44 through Pembridge to the Water Gardens, which are located a couple of miles further on, on the left.

Tuesday 17th August, 7pm. Brobury House Gardens, Brobury, HR3 6BS *Owned by Prue and Keith Cartwright*.

Five acres of garden set on the banks of the River Wye includes Victorian terraces with mature specimen trees. Beautiful water features, architectural plantings, woodland areas, mixed borders and decorative kitchen garden with glass house and pergola.

Admission. £6; tea and cake £4, coffee and cake £5

Directions. From Leominster take the A44/A4112 through to Kinnersley, then take the next small turning on the left to Letton. At the junction with the A438 turn left and after a short distance turn

right towards Bredwardine (Brobury Lane), at the T-junction just before the bridge crossing to Bredwardine, Brobury House will be in front of you.
