Minutes of the Face to Face Parish Council Meeting at Kimbolton Village Hall on Tuesday 4th
October 2022 at 7.45pm

 - 4.1 **Footpaths – (Brian Tonks)**
 - It has been reported that the gate at the church yard won't close on Paul Phillip's land. The gate has warped and fallen off the hinges – work is required for repair.
 - Kill horse lane – it has been reported that non slip covering is required on the walkway.
 - 4.2 **Lengthsman - (Brian Tonks).**

 - 4.3 **Drainage Grant**
 - Drainage works will commence w/c 10/10
 - Works at Stanley Bank have been completed.
 - 4.4 **Update on A4112 Road Safety/Speeding.**
 - SID has been active over the last month.
 - Members of the public raise concerns that speeding is still an issue in the village and there seems to be more HGV traffic travelling through the village.
 - Recommendations discussed included signage on the A49 stating road isn't suitable for AHGVs
 - Further recommendations that more 30 speed signs are placed throughout the village and a second SID was also discussed.
 - A recommendation of hiring a speed gun was made by a member of the public, Cllr Ed Rollings is to investigate the legality and cost. Further discussions will be required.
