#### WELCOME

We have relished Wimbledon, The Test and Women's football, (a little men's too), but we must not forget the sporting talent in our midst. So this time we celebrate our own sports teams.

First, well done to Kimbolton Rifle Club who were runners up in the North Herefordshire League (2nd div), recently, with Ricky Reno having the highest average score.

The Club, which is over a century old, was formed after the First World War. Between 1919 and 1921 the members of the club built the 'Kimbolton Rifle Club Room', entering into an agreement with Edwin Colebatch, William Goodman and Thomas Davies who owned the land.

In 1946 a trust was formed with the Charity Commissioners. The first trustees were all members of the Rifle Club, and the property was conveyed to the inhabitants of the Parish of Kimbolton for:

"purposes of physical, recreational and social use without distinction of sex or of political religious or other opinions "

The building became known as the Kimbolton Club Room and over the years many other events were held there, including the daytime use of the Hall by the reception class of the village school.

In 1998 the old tin hall was demolished to be replaced by the current hall. It remains the venue for the Air Rifle Club whose early members were far-sighted and generous enough to provide Kimbolton residents with their own village hall.

The Club hopes to start again on Wednesday October 11th for the new season. All welcome. Members should be over 12 years.




