

THREADS THROUGH CREATION

An acclaimed Devon textile artist's dazzling interpretation of the story of creation is to be the centrepiece of an exciting festival in Herefordshire this summer.

Jacqui Parkinson's 'Threads through Creation' will be on display at Leominster Priory from Wednesday 5 June until Thursday 18 July 2024. The installation features twelve huge textile panels, which are inspired by the first pages of the bible. In the three years they took to make, Jacqui used countless yards of sumptuous silks, miles of thread and more than 8 million stitches to create one of the largest textile art projects by a single artist in the world.

Inspired by the same theme, there will be a second exhibition showcasing the skills and artistry of some of Leominster's community groups and institutions. Organised by Priory Arts on behalf of Leominster Priory, an array of events will run for the duration of the festival – including a weekly 'Let's Create' craft activities café, musical performances and theatre, themed walks and nature talks, creative workshops and celebratory church services.

LENGTHSMAN TO RETIRE AFTER 23 YEARS

Brian Tonks, Parish Lengthsman for Kimbolton since 2001 has announced his retirement. His dedicated service and his tireless commitment to the parish will be greatly missed.

The Parish Lengthsman scheme was started by Herefordshire Council for minor works to be carried out in local parishes, like cleaning road signs, checking on salt boxes, clearing gullies and vegetation, to save calling in contractors from Hereford. Kimbolton Parish Council joined the scheme right from the start and unlike some parishes, has stayed in the scheme over the years.

We have benefitted from Brian's considerable expertise in potholes, road repairs and drainage and his work has doubtless saved Herefordshire thousands of pounds.



There was a similar scheme for Rights of Way and footpaths, funded by Herefordshire Council and Brian checked stiles and kissing gates, repairing or replacing them when necessary. He could locate every stile in the parish and marked every salt-box, essential in winter, with a large stake. The funding for footpaths and Public Rights of Way (PROWS) was eventually withdrawn but the Parish Council, to its credit, has continued to fund both schemes. It was Brian's idea to number each Right of Way and he looked after the planters at either end of the village.

Brian carried out his work in a voluntary capacity.

Herefordshire Council is once again funding the Lengthsman Scheme and whilst Brian will no longer be patrolling the lanes and footpaths I am sure we will continue to consult him, and I am confident that the Parish Council will ensure that Kimbolton stays in the scheme

Thank you Brian for all you have done for these parishes and best wishes to you and Jean for healthier days ahead so that you can enjoy your much deserved retirement.

THE EASTER TRIDUUM EXPLAINED

There are a number of Church services in the week leading up to Easter. Palm Sunday marks the beginning of what we refer to as 'Holy Week.'

The main focus of Easter begins on (Maundy) Thursday, with the celebration of Holy Communion and the Washing of Feet, a service that ends without a blessing and in silence and the stripping of the Church alter



This is reminiscent of the disciples scattering after Jesus is arrested in the Garden of Gethsemane; the service on Good Friday begins in silence without a greeting and ends in silence without a blessing, and is a reminder of the disciples and others coming and going below the Cross on which Jesus has been crucified.

Late on Saturday evening or very early on Sunday morning, the Easter Vigil service is celebrated, beginning in darkness with the lighting of a fire and the big Easter Candle, followed by a series of readings reminding us of God's activity in history. This culminates with Jesus' ministry and death, flowing on into another celebration of Holy Communion and acclamation of Jesus' resurrection to new life, and the service ends with a blessing.

So while it may look like three different services, the three services are in fact all part of one service and it is helpful to attend and experience all three in order to fully experience the Easter story.


