

They came from the Market Tavern in Tenbury during the summer, and have ten years' experience as publicans.

Greg told us:

"We had been looking at pubs along the canals, as I have, in the past, lived on boats, but we loved the history and feel of The Stockton Cross".

"We want to develop a proper community pub with simple food".

"Already Sunday lunches are proving popular and in January we have been planning our events for the spring and summer. Thursdays will be Pizza nights (including take out), and we hope to develop our vinyl nights, and some community events like live music and boules."

“We really need local people to get behind us and support their pub”. He said.

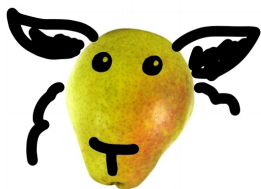
