That should brighten up those murky February evenings!

All that, plus events for you to enjoy, ways to help our wildlife through winter and new activities popping up as fast as the snowdrops.

But first that lead story.

OWNERS PLEDGE NEW START FOR THE STOCKTON CROSS

Customers of our 'local' were delighted to be invited to meet Kate Lane, owner of The Stockton Cross and three other pubs in the Baiting House collection, and young chef Harry Tyler, on Christmas day to hear about their exciting plans.

After yet another closure at The Stockton Cross, it was a welcome surprise for loyal customers.

From the end of January, they learned, a spruced-up Stockton Cross will re-open, initially for drinks and from early February for home-made locally-sourced food, produced by a new bespoke team. And happily, Harry and Kate came again to talk to Roundabout in the New Year to give us more details.

Harry told us: "I am a Worcester boy and have always loved being in a kitchen. I went to catering college and joined the Baiting House Group in 2017 training under Head Chef Charles Bradley. I loved the team there".

"I left to go to London for more experience and worked as a chef in several successful restaurants before taking a trip to Australia for six months".

"To my delight, when I came home recently, I had a call from Kate asking if I would like to take on the Stockton Cross and build my own team. I was thrilled, it was an instant 'yes'. The perfect opportunity at the perfect time".

Kate said; "There was an element of fate about it, I think."

"Andrew my husband, and I had a few difficult years personally, and were perhaps not as 'hands on' recently with the Stockton Cross as we should have been. We always appreciated the loyalty of local customers and now we are delighted to have a great new chef in Harry, and a refurbished pub all ready to welcome them again."

Kate and Andrew met at university, he was from Manchester, but she is very much a local girl.

"My great grandfather farmed at Upton Court, Middleton on-the-Hill, he was Oliver Dowdig Lane. He had 250 acres, staff and servants ...but lost it all gambling in the 1880s. His wife had died after giving birth to my grandfather so, leaving him in the care of relatives, Oliver went to farm in Australia."

"My father was born in Upper Sapey, so when, after living and working in London and Oxfordshire, we moved back, it felt right to buy not only our house but the Baiting House, our 'local' and try to revive it."

The rest is history. They now have three thriving pubs of which they are rightly proud, and hopefully the Stockton Cross will join them once more.

Harry, a Rugby enthusiast and wild swimmer, has already helped them oversee some improvements although he says there is more to be done, but they are all keen to get the doors open again first and carry out more improvements in the months ahead.

"We shall have beer from Wye Valley Brewery with guest ales from time to time and the food will be hearty, home-made and a great combination."

"I have already had some approaches from local people wanting to join the new team and would welcome anyone who is interested."



THERE'S NO HOLE LIKE HOME...

Members of the Leominster area branch of Herefordshire Wildlife Trust, some of whom live in our villages, are intending to put up bird boxes in the local area in February so I want to share with you an article from the Wildlife Trust:

Many garden birds nest or roost in hollow trees and holes in trees. Unfortunately, these days most old and dying trees and branches, which offer the best nesting and roosting sites, are routinely cut down and removed. This leaves fewer places for birds to set up homes and raise families.

Specially constructed nest boxes imitate the holes and cavities in dead standing wood that are usually cleared away.

A bird box can be a real help to garden birds – an estimated 2 million fledglings are reared in nest boxes each year. And it's a wonderful feeling to see a blue tit or robin investigating a nest box that you made and put up yourself.


