If Yoga isn't your thing perhaps gardening is? We are 'nearer to God's heart in the garden than anywhere else on earth' according to Dorothy Frances Gurney 1913.

In Hamnish, Penny Morris is certainly happy in her garden where she is busily planting flowers to cut and sell, catching up on a very wet winter.

" I have never planted this early but it's been a slow start and I am having to try out some new flowers to add to the collection".

This will be the first year that Penny is full time in her flower beds and poly tunnel, having recently retired, and she's hoping for a busy season.

" 90 per cent of florists' flowers are imported, some from as far away as Ethiopia, and there is a growing realisation that this is not sustainable."

You can find Penny and her flowers at the Leominster in Bloom plant and craft fair in May at The Grange, at the Leominster Farmers' markets or the Leominster Food Fayre in September. She also supplies wedding and special occasion buckets for customers to arrange themselves.

The weather was kind when members of the Leominster Area branch of Herefordshire Wildlife Trust met at Leominster Cemetery to put up eight bird boxes, (as featured last time). Much of the ground was carpeted in primroses but there were only a few clumps of snowdrops at the far side of the cemetery. They will try to add some more of these early flowers earmarking a sunny bank near the road for crocus naturalisation. This should encourage more insects for the nesting birds as well as providing extra spring beauty for people visiting.


LAMBING SEASON IS NOT FOR THE FAINT HEARTED

As I have been writing this time, the weather has varied from glorious warm sunshine, through gale force winds to freezing hail. For me, (and probably you too) this can be depressing, but for farmers in the midst of lambing it's challenging to put it mildly.

Spare a thought for Tim Bunting in Kimbolton who, whilst we are abed, has been watching over 120 ewes in lamb, day and night, helping them to deliver the next generation.

Since coming to Grove Farm with his wife Fiona in 1983 they have reared pigs, cattle and sheep but now it's predominantly sheep. Their ewes are North Country Mules crossed with a pedigree Suffolk tup, which according to Tim are a sturdy lot.

This year the early members of the flock have safely delivered two and some three healthy lambs each, which will be sold into the market in Tenbury. Hopefully this productive start will continue into April.



THE VIKINGS ARE COMING!

SAVE THE DATE: 30 & 31 ST MAY, LEOMINSTER PRIORY



Not to be missed: the Vikings invade Leominster (again).

A pitched battle will take place in the Grange near Leominster Priory at 3pm both Saturday and Sunday afternoon of 30th and 31st May, Vikings v Saxons. This is the highlight of an action-packed family-friendly weekend featuring re-enactors from Regia Anglorum.

There will be a living village to explore, with demonstrations of Viking/Saxon life, arts and crafts, a fashion show, plus a chance to experience their music, religious services, and warrior training.

A full-sized replica Viking ship inside the Priory is a must-see, part of a free exhibition, open daily 10-4, exploring the significance of the Vikings in Herefordshire and the culture and art of the Anglo Saxons. Get a close-up look at the (replica) Herefordshire Hoard – the fabulous treasure trove buried in the 9th century and re-discovered just outside the town in 2015.

The exhibition features the first public view of 'The Hereford Gospels Today', together with art inspired by the Hereford Cathedral Saxon Gospels, including illuminated art by Marches Scribes and the work of students from Hereford College of Art. There will also be thought-provoking displays by local artists and community groups inspired by the theme of treasure.

The May weekend is part of a month-long series of free and paid events in and around Leominster Priory. With guided walks, talks, concerts, drama and craft workshops, there is something for everyone, and activities to appeal to all ages.
