Year 6 Leavers say 'goodbye' to St. James the Great Primary at the end of term after an amazingly successful year.



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WELCOME

WELCOME to our August and September edition, which has a very positive vibe.

Without doubt the weather has dominated activities of late, but despite the challenges we look at positive developments in farming for the future locally.

The new Marsh Court Medical centre is finally open, and is a triumph of local generosity and dogged persistence by those who have fought for it over fifteen years. We have more summer events for you to enjoy, including the Annual Cricket Match on 23rd August in Kingsland and the Wheels Festival at The Duke of York on 30th August and news of a local resident who has returned with big plans for fitness activities in Leysters.

But first, farming for the future.

FARMING FOR THE FUTURE

We are a farming community and we enjoy the benefit of a beautiful landscape.

We can, of late, also enjoy the new field margins full of flowers and herbs covered by a wealth of butterflies and bees.

However, some may not have realised that they are part of a new way of farming being embraced by one local family, adapting farming methods to confront climate change, both for profitability and to help the environment.

Pete Duggan is the fourth generation of his family to farm in Kimbolton and his two sons the fifth. Pete and Matt work full time on the farm and Nick helps out and oversees the agronomy. Sixth generation Archie has yet to join the team!

Together they are embracing 'regenerative farming', and if you haven't heard the term before read on...it affects us all.

They told us:

"The Autumn of 2019 was exceptionally wet and trying to get crops established proved very difficult. Some of the wheat seeds that we had planted had rotted leaving us with a lot of spring planting to complete alongside re-planting for the crops that had failed."

"We decided that we needed to change our systems to make the soil more resilient and improve its structure, enabling us to cope with weather extremes, be it floods or drought.

"This involved five main things:

- Minimising soil disturbance to protect soil structure and soil life and reduce carbon emissions.
- Keeping soil covered with cover crops or residues to prevent erosion and feed microbes.
- Maximising plant diversity by companion cropping as mixed species build resilience, improves soil biology, and supports wildlife.
- Keeping living roots in the ground as year-round root activity boosts carbon and nutrient cycling.
- Grazing livestock on herbal leys and cover crops to recycle nutrients and stimulate plant growth.
- Soil sampling and plant sap analysis helping us to assess deficiencies to make the plants more resilient, reducing the use of fungicides and insecticides and some artificial inputs."

"After doing this for a couple of years we realised that we were now growing a crop that would fit the specification of like-minded companies, potentially adding value to our grain as well as helping the environment and long term, the health of the consumer."

"We came across Wildfarmed and started growing for them in 2025".

Wildfarmed was set up by three young men with a mission to scale up regenerative agriculture and bring food grown in nature-rich landscapes to the high street...that is better food from better farms to the consumer.

It's been quite a journey for Wildfarmed but they are gaining more and more profile (look them up it's a fascinating young company.).

"Wildfarmed markets all types of flours for bread making, baking, and are currently selling to a range of organisations from Artisan bakeries, pizzarias, through to larger groups such as Waitrose, Tesco and their newest achievement Kitkat."

"We are now growing crops in an environmentally, sustainable way and are proud to be a Wildfarmed grower."
