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WELCOME

WELCOME to the Autumn edition of Roundabout.

Finally, the rain came and we are straight into harvest. This year is the United Nations' International Year of the Woman Farmer so we are learning more about the women working on our farms locally.

We have harvest festivals, National Poetry Day and a myriad events and news for you to enjoy.

But first, those farming women.

Agricultural colleges in the UK report a surge in female enrolment; now making up over 64 per cent of students and it's said they are bringing fresh skills, especially in engineering, computer science and environmental policy. They are also said to excel at business development and creativity.

Laura Beaumont lives in Luston although her family farms in Kimbolton as they have for four generations before. Both she and her mother and sisters are very much hands on at their 65acre farm, with father Mick.

But that's not all. She told us...

"I have a full-time job for the British on-farm Innovation Network as Head of Projects" she told us; "but when I come home, I just love to get back on the tractor or help my dad out with whatever the season demands."

"I went to Australia in 2014 and again in 2020 and loved experiencing farming over there. I like to know how our machinery works and combining is a favourite, although they are very long days...and nights."

"My mother retrained as an accountant which is an essential part of running the farm. I think women were always involved but today their contribution is more recognised and computer skills in particular are essential".

A slightly different view of the industry comes from Kate Miller and Orla Harrison who are both working for the Smith family this harvest time. Bill, Nicky and Jack Smith grow potatoes at Park Farm in Kimbolton and are suppliers to McCain and McDonalds.

Kate who's 26, comes from North Yorkshire and has a background in dairy. She has a degree in Geophysics.

After time working for a John Deere dealership, she decided to focus on widening her agricultural skills.

"I enjoy the variety that working on a farm brings. From planting and harvest to working with livestock. Every day I get to experience something different."

"There have always been women on farms but our contributions are now more widely recognised and celebrated. I hope that young people are inspired by what we do and seek out opportunities in agriculture."

"Orla who comes from Worcestershire said;

"I agree, there's plenty of variety in farming and many more women are coming on board. I think we bring brains, a caring approach and an eye for diversification".

I really enjoy moving from farm to farm as the seasons unfold."

And, if we need further proof that the new generation of women farmers are up for a challenge Laura told us;

"I am pregnant at the moment but I still managed to drive a combine for the harvest last month. And I hope I can pass on my passion and love for the land and farming to my children, boys or girls".

St Mary's graveyard had a very wet winter. It must have rained every day for at least three months. The ground got so wet and heavy that it pushed over the dry-stone wall on the western side of the churchyard. Parishioners were shocked and mortified that it happened so quickly.

At the first PCC meeting of 2026 there was much discussion and it was agreed that funds for our long-awaited sink unit and water connection into the vestry would have to go on hold. The money was needed for the walls and making the graveyard secure.

Many people have a connection to this place, either because they have family graves here or because they are related to past farm workers that lived and worked in this rural setting. We have a steady stream of visitors looking for their ancestors, asking for help when looking for a grave stone or just visiting this very peaceful place.

If you are one of these families and would like St Mary's church to continue to provide a service of support within the community, I hope you will consider making a donation to our wall building fund. We will be putting this year's fund raising from the harvest service and auction to the cause, but wall building does cost a lot!
